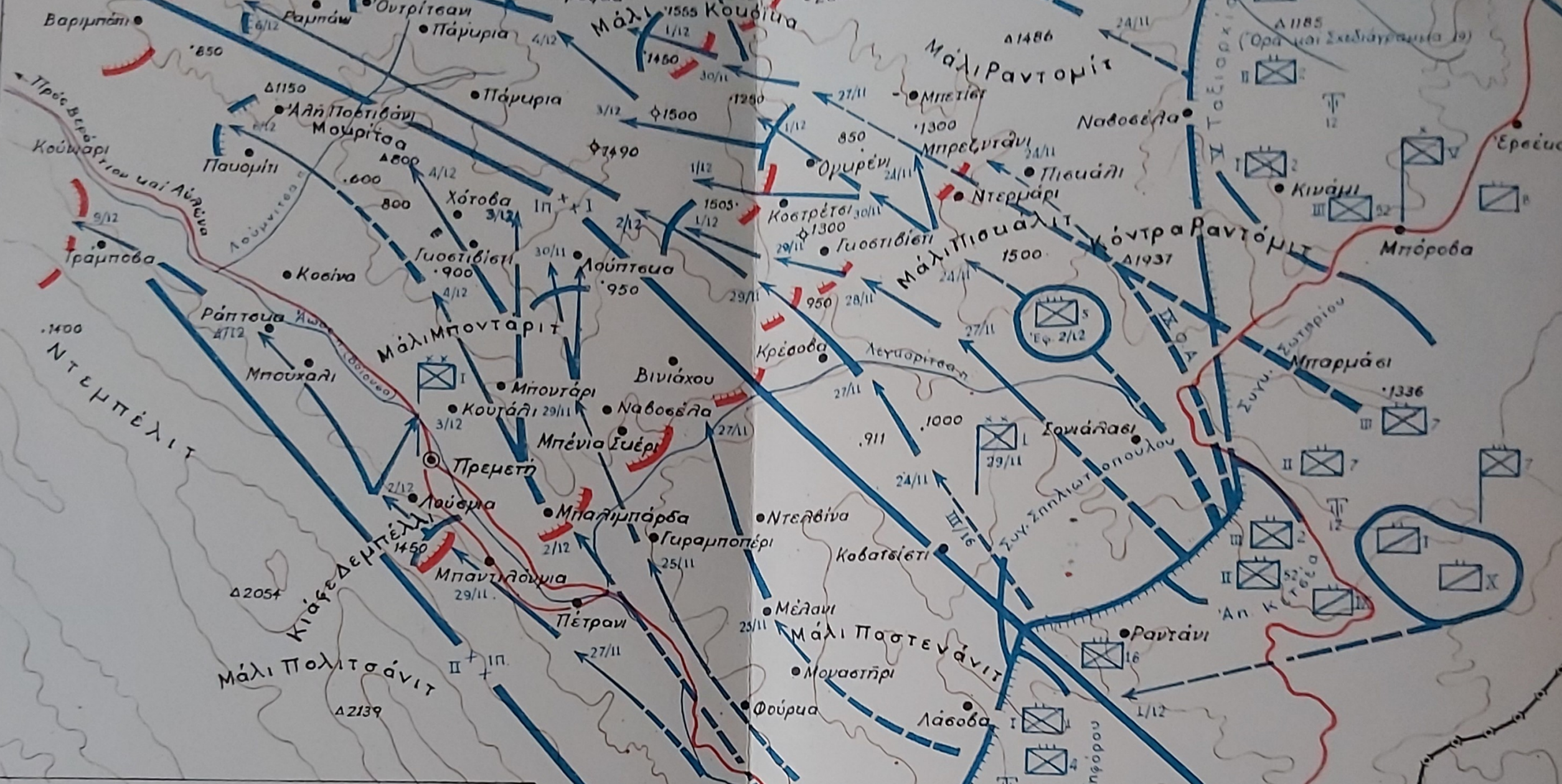

The user, an arts and humanities researcher or scholar, can use the registries to access information

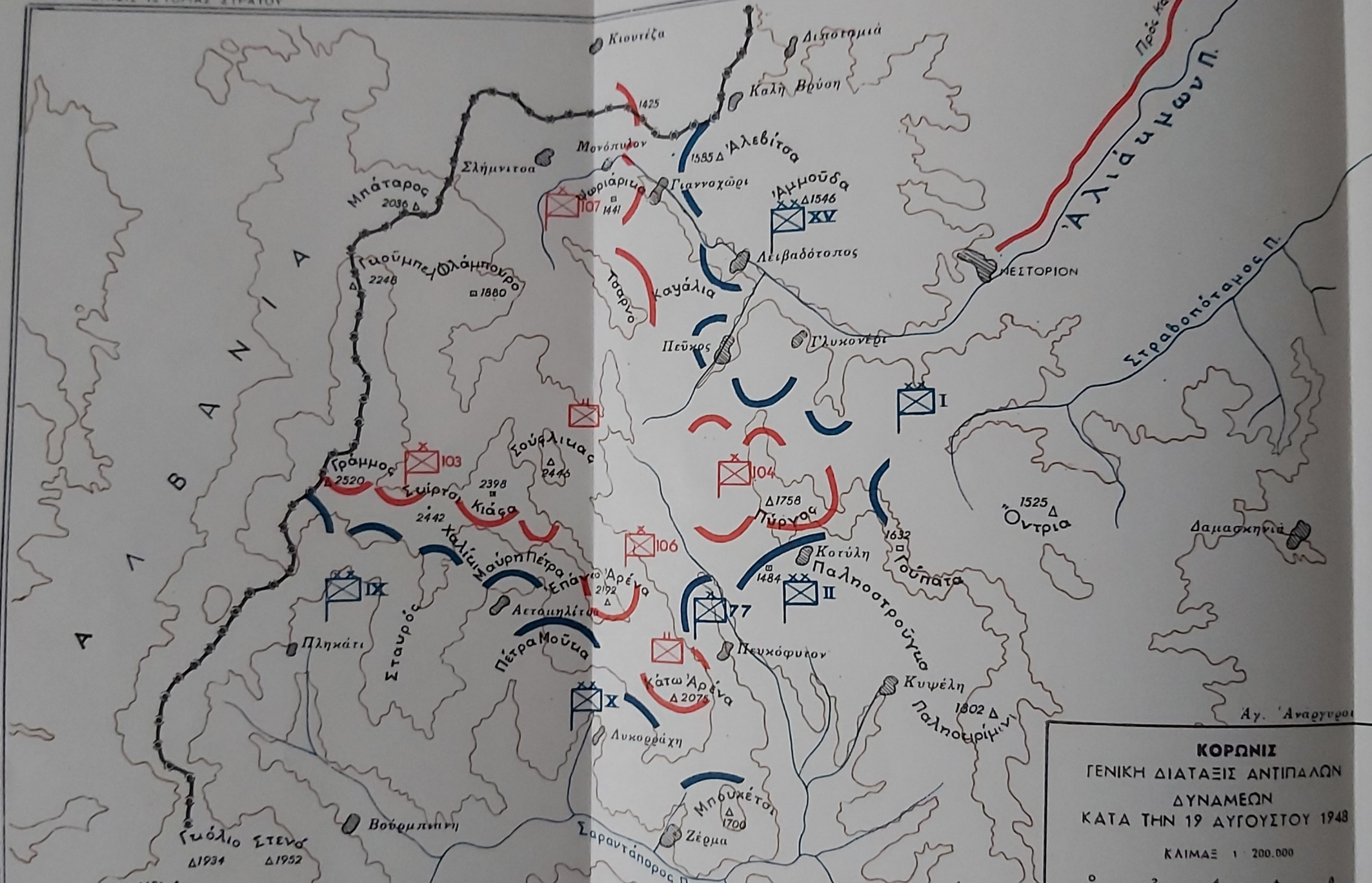
