INTRODUCTORY

While compiling the Catalogue of my Library, I have gathered together, in a special section, such items as relate to & elucidate the history of the Greek War of Independence, as well as to the events which immediately preceded and influenced the Revolution of 1821; for a study of those events is essential to a lucid conception of what followed.

Of this period of European history - from the last quarter of the eighteenth century to the year 1833 - there exists, as far as I am aware, no comprehensive bibliography; whereas the material to be found scattered in various directions, & in several languages, especially in the form of out of the way fugitive literature, is extensive & rich. Without a careful consideration of it no reliable history of the Greek Revolution can be written, and such a history has yet to be produced.

Much of this literature is not easy of access, and certain items, especially those issued in very small editions in Greece during the War, and partly destroyed during the vicissitudes of an eight years devastating warfare, are, generally speaking, unobtainable. But every item here recorded rests on my shelves in a faultless condition in all cases, and often in an exceptionally fine state. I was fortunate enough, some years ago, to have the pick of two or three old collections in Greece: and during a life time I have spared no effort or sacrifice in forming an essentially Greek library.

Introductory Note.

This Bibliography is the result of extensive research and much labour. After considerable preliminary study it was commenced about May 1923 and rapidly prosecuted through June & July. But the pressure of other urgent matters did not allow of its completion on the extensive & very full scale projected. Not only this, but, as it will be inferred from the interpositions and additions in the following pages, much of the matter hurriedly gathered was interposed subsequently. Chapter E relating to the ΕΑΑΗΝΙΚΗ ΒΙΒΛΙΟΘΗΚΗ is only outlined here, and the matter for four or five no less important chapters additional chapters still remains in rough notes, to be filled in and extended, as the rest of this historical bibliography, at some future date; for this work, which is much needed and desired by scholars, has never been attempted before.

A more concise bibliography of the Coray Collection in this Library - a collection unrivalled in fulness and perfection of state - is in preparation and will soon follow, as a part of the General Catalogue.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE - ΒΙΟΓΡΑΦΙΚΟ ΣΗΜΕΙΩΜΑ


Ali Pasha (1774-1822) was an Albanian brigand, who became Pasha of Ioannina, and extended his rule over much of Albania, Macedonia, Epirus, Thessaly, and the Morea. In Ali Pasha's time, Ioannina became the foremost center of Greek culture. He employed many Greeks and founded Greek schools.





TOPOGRAPHIES OF PHERAE AND ATHENS, ISLE OF CORFU AND THE OPPOSITE SHORE OF THE HIMARA AREA

This sheet contains the title of the map ("Charta of Greece, which includes her islands and part of her many colonies in Europe and Asia Minor lying in the east from the Myra of Lycia to Mt. Arganthon of Bithynia; to the north up to Ak-Kerman [Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi], the Carpathian mountains and the rivers Danube and Sava; to the west from the river Una [Sava] to Ionian Sea; to the south down to the Libyan Sea. Most of them [these locations] with both their old and new names. Also, 9 topographies of some of Greece's celebrated cities and places, made for the understanding of the 'Jeune Anacharsis'; a chronology of its kings and important figures; 161 types of Greek coins, selected from the Imperial Treasury of Austria to provide knowledge of
