Until today more than 2,400 institutions and 2,000 collections are recorded in the registry.












Issues during registration process

Communication problems with institutions
Remote institutions like museums, monasteries in Athos etc. with out internet connection, fax or even phone

Institutions don't respond in a reasonable time.

Sometimes, more effort is needed in order Institutions to be persuaded to give the required information.





National Initiatives

National Documentation Center (EKT) HELIOS (http://helios-eie.ekt.gr/EIE/?locale=en)

The repository provides free and unrestricted access to scientific content produced by researchers at National Hellenic Research Foundation (NHRF).

Open Archives by (EKT) (http://www.openarchives.gr/)

A portal for most of the depositories in Greece.

Anemi (http://anemi.lib.uoc.gr/)

Digital Library aims to provide simple and quick access to a rich collection of digitized material related to Modern Greek Studies

Cosmopolis (http://xantho.lis.upatras.gr/kosmopolis/)

The digital collection Cosmopolis includes the full text of 14 literature journals circulated in Greek state, but also in the wider Greek world, from 1834 to 1930





International Initiatives in Greece

Michael and Michael plus (http://www.michael-culture.gr/mpf/pub-mpf/about.html#proj)

The MICHAEL database is based on national inventories of digital resources that have been created by the project partners. Each national inventory includes descriptions of digital collections and the websites, CD-ROMS and other products and services that have been created by museums, libraries and archives.

Europeana (http://www.europeana.eu/portal/)

Several institutions from Greece participate in Europeana Project, like the National Library of Greece and the National Hellenic Research Foundation.





Differences between DARIAH-GR Collection Registry and other initiatives

Dariah-GR registry is an aggregation of collections, not a repository of individual documents. Researchers addressed to institutions for the documents of a collection.

The registry comprises equally both digital and non-digital collections.

Researchers have at their disposal digital and non-digital collections in one single registry.
