DARIAH-GR and the greek humanities landscape

National Bank of Greece Research programmes

From the beginning of the 1980' s, had financed three cycles of research programmes carried out by external researchers:

a. The first cycle comprised a series of monographs that covered aspects of the financial history of Greece in the 19th and early 20th century and culminated to 36 publications classified in three series: Studies of the economic history, Sources of the economic history and Processed Data from the Economic history of Greece. A photostatic reprint and four catalogues and indexes also published.

b. The second cycle focused on a wide research project named "Economic History Resources of Modern Greece. Quantitive and Statistical series, 1830-1939" concerning the creation of financial data series of six basic figures of the Greek economy during the years 1839-1940.

Cross Domestic Product, 1830-1939.

Prices and Price Indexes, 1830-1939.

Public Expenditure (consumer, transfer, investment) 1830-1939.

Public Revenue 1830-1939.

Public Dept (domestic, foreign), 1830-1939.

Banking and Monetary System, 1830-1939.

c. Finally, the third cycle concerned two multiple research programs, the first one referring to: "The History of the NBG 1841-1940" and the second one to "The financial history of the Modern Hellenic Nation".

February 2011 Preparing DARIAH project completed

February 2011 Feasibility study for DARIAH-GR completed

May 2013 Launching of DARIAH-GR construction project

February 2014 Greece becomes a founding member of DARIAH-EU
