- **2006:** DARIAH included in the ESFRI Roadmap
- **2008 – 2011:** Preparatory Phase project, *Preparing DARIAH*
- **2011 – 2013:** ‘Transition Phase’, establishing the DARIAH-ERIC, integrating national activities
- **2014+:** DARIAH-ERIC

...for researchers, by researchers...

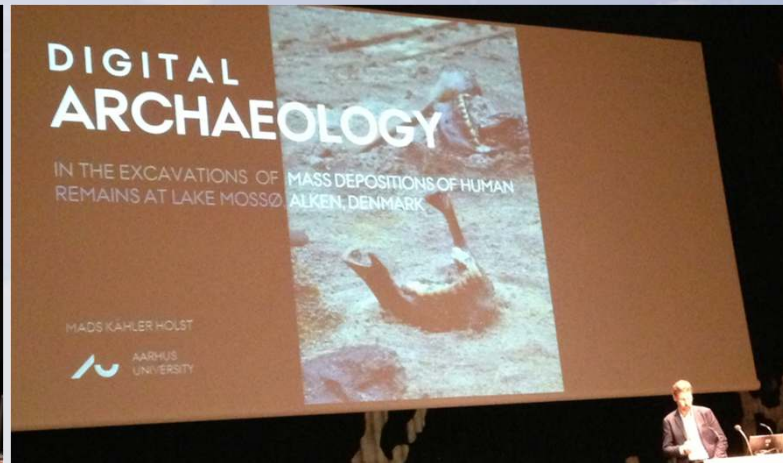

3rd DARIAH-EU General VCC meeting

We are happy to invite all DARIAHns to join our 3rd DARIAH-EU General VCC meeting which will take place on 5 and 6 September 2013 in Copenhagen.

Two top priorities will lead us through the meeting this time. The first is an overview of what we have achieved in DARIAH and can already been offered as a service to the community. The second focus is on cross-VCC activities e.g. the ontology and registry of services or publications.

VCC e-Infrastructure	Will establish a shared infrastructure platform for the VCCs and the community for research.
VCC Research and Education Liaison	Will explore with VCCs and the community how to improve research and education.
VCC Scholarly Content Management	Will explore the requirements and sharing of scholarly content.
VCC Advocacy, Impact and Outreach	Will interface with the community and the VCCs and Humanities.
